OVERALL RULES: Girls who will be a junior the 2009-2010 school year or reach the age of 16 between September 16, 2008 and September 15, 2009 are eligible. Participation is limited to one year. She must attend Ankeny High School and/or reside within the Ankeny School district.

All girls must participate in the following:

*Meeting designed especially for the Miss 16 contestants-**Sunday, June 7 at 6:30 pm**

*Grand Parade on **Saturday, July 11, 9:00am-line up at 8:00 am**

attire for the parade is the commemorative shirt with shorts, skirt or pants.

*Contest Ceremony on **Saturday, July 11, 7:30pm,**

attire for the contest is casual summer dress

She must agree to take part in both divisions of the Miss Sixteen Contest. Contestant must have written consent of a parent or guardian to participate.

Forms must be returned complete with sponsor fee to the SummerFest Office, Chamber of Commerce Building, 210 South Ankeny Blvd or mailed to Ankeny SummerFest, PO Box 243, Ankeny, IA 50021 no later than May 8, 2009.

SPONSORSHIP: Each contestant is responsible for obtaining a local Ankeny business to sponsor her in the contest. The cost to the business for sponsoring a contestant is \$75. This covers the contestant's portrait, flowers, T-shirt and related expenses of the contest. Have your sponsor make a check payable to ANKENY SUMMERFEST and include payment with your registration form. **Please verify with your sponsor, the correct spelling and correct format of their business name for programs and t-shirts, incorrect information cannot be changed after submission for printing.** Some sponsor name format changes could occur due to printing size restrictions. Most local businesses are willing to sponsor Miss 16 contestants, especially businesses that you and your family patronize-banks, doctors, hair salons, restaurants, etc.

MISS PHOTOGENIC: Please refer to the enclosure from Jamison Studios for additional portrait information. Contact Jamison Studios for questions regarding portraits, sittings, etc. Portraits will be taken by appointment only. Please call Jamison Studios as soon as possible for your portrait appointment. Appointments will begin in March. Bring a parent with you to your photo session, as portrait selections will be made at the time of your sitting. Contest portraits will be available at the June 7 Clinic. Portraits must be placed in your sponsors business establishment at least 2 weeks prior to SummerFest, no later than June 26 and you must pick up your portrait after the weekend of SummerFest. Miss Photogenic winner will receive a \$50 Saving Bond. 1st and 2nd runner-ups and 4 Honorable Mentions will be recognized.

MISS SCHOLASTIC: Each contestant will complete a brief composition. Topic will be announced for all contestants at the clinic on June 7. Judging will be based on content originality and creativity. Miss Scholastic will receive a \$50 Savings Bond. 2nd and 3rd place and 4 Honorable Mentions will be recognized.

All winners will be announced July 11 at the ceremony at Northview Stadium.

Appointment Dates: Appointments must be scheduled by May 15th and taken between March 1st and May 22nd. (Hours available during spring break)

Photo Session: Your Miss 16 photo session includes 1 outfit, 8 different looks or poses and a single background choice. Appointments will take approximately 30-45 minutes, **you will be viewing your images following the session.** You will then have an opportunity to purchase additional portraits at discounted pricing. All additional orders are to be paid for when ordered. A retake charge of \$20 will be imposed if you would like additional (non-contestant) portraits taken with a second outfit or a different background, or on another day to change hair style, clothing or background set.

Clothing: Unless you have smooth shoulders and arms, we suggest you wear sleeves, avoid straps showing, tan lines, etc. Your choice of seasonal outfits will be fine, such as turtlenecks, spring dresses, summer blouses, or fall sweaters. We will compliment the outfit with the background. We just want you to feel great and look happy. Solid colors are suggested.

Additional Suggestions

To help make a better portrait for you it is strongly recommended that you wear cover-up make up and some skin soft powder, if you have naturally oily skin or blemishes. We strongly encourage you to have your finger nails painted, your hands may be part of the portrait. Also avoid glitter type makeup as it reflects light and may cause unflattering speckles on your face. Hair spray, brush, curling iron are items that may be brought to touch up your hair before the session begins.

Additional artwork on non-contestant portraits such as; Super soft focus, blurred backgrounds, softening other lines or clothing, remove stray hair, enhance eye color, whiten teeth, remove braces, or remove moles. Priced as follows; remove blemishes is included, stray hair \$5, braces \$20, whiten teeth \$3, change background color \$5. (Portraits with additional artwork are not eligible for the Miss 16 Contest.)

Portrait: The 11x14 contest print will be retouched, for blemishes and shine only at no cost. All portraits will be delivered to the Miss 16 Committee on or by June 7th. The photos will be available for viewing at Jamison Studios until then. Portraits will not be allowed to be taken out of the studio prior to the June 7th date.

Special pricing on framing your 11x14 portrait will be available when you choose your print.

Come early to your appointment to look at samples of backgrounds and poses. We will also do a facial analysis to use proper lighting and posing techniques to better enhance your portrait experience.
